Psalm 145

Read all of Psalm 145

1. Make two columns below. Give the left column the title “Attributes” and title the right column “Actions”. Reading carefully through the entire Psalm again, list each attribute (characteristic or defining quality) of God that the Psalmist mentions in the left hand column, and in the right column write down every action or deed of God that he lists. (Please notate the verse.)

2. a. Which one or two of the attributes you listed above are most precious to you at this time in your life, and why?

b. Which one of the LORD’s deeds that you recorded above are you especially thankful for?

3. The Psalmist makes several personal declarations. Record each statement you find which begins, "I will..." notating the verse where it is found.

4. Now record each phrase that tells something that others will do: "_____ will...", or "they will...", identifying who "they" are. (You may need to glance back a verse or two to determine the source of the action, or they may be named directly at the start of the phrase.)

5. Focus on verse 4. How do you currently fulfill this responsibility?

6. What are your primary areas of influence or involvement outside of your home? What does obeying, proclaiming, serving, giving and going look like in the arenas where the LORD has placed you?

7. Make note of any other thoughts you have concerning this Psalm that you would like to discuss with your small group. (Or with the LORD in prayer!)
