	b) How do these descriptions inform how and why we should heed God's voice?
2.	Read Numbers 14:21-30, the account of the rebellion that Psalm 95 and Hebrews 3 refer to as "the rebellion in the desert."
	a) What circumstances led to the Israelites' rebellion?
	b) What circumstances or unmet expectations in your own life tempt you to believe that God is not trustworthy?

3.	According to verses 12-14, what are some ways to keep your heart from being hardened by unbelief?
4.	What friends or family members encourage you to persevere in faith? How do you serve in that role for others? Can you think of any specific time when this occurred that you could share in your group?
5.	How are you tempted to place your confidence in something or someone other than God? What area of hardness of heart might this reveal?
6.	Thinking back over our study to this point, what truths about Christ do you need to trust more fully to help you hold fast to the end?
