Hebrews 6:13-20

Read Hebrews 6:13-20.

1. Abraham is an example of one of “those who through faith and patience inherit the promises” (look back to verse 12). Read Genesis 12:1-5.

a) What did God promise Abraham?

b) How old was Abraham at this time? Why does the fulfillment of God’s promise seem improbable?

2. When Abraham is 100 years old, his son, Isaac, is born (see Genesis 21). Read Genesis 22:1-18. What did God ask Abraham to do to his son? How did Abraham demonstrate faith during this situation?

3. According to Genesis 22:16 and Hebrews 6:13-14, what kind of oath did God make? Why do you think God confirmed his promise this way?

4. How are we heirs of the promise to Abraham (v. 17)?

5. God's promise and his oath are both unchangeable (the two unchangeable things in v. 18). How does it encourage you to know that God does not lie but always speaks truth?

6. In what current circumstance do you need to flee to God for refuge and hold on to the hope offered to you? How can you anchor your soul in him?

7. Which of God's promises help you hold on to hope? Remember that this week!
