Read all of Psalm 148

- a. From verses 1-4, make a list of all the parts of creation commanded to praise the LORD.
 - b. How do verses 5-6 explain why they should praise Him?
- a. From verses 7-12, again list all of the parts of creation that are commanded to praise the LORD.
 - b. From verses 13-14, why are they to praise Him?
3. Re-read verses 1-6. Read also Psalm 19:1-6. How do the “heavenly bodies” reveal truths about God? How does this passage connect with Romans 1:20, which speaks of God’s invisible attributes being seen in creation?

4. How does recognizing God as Creator shape our worship?
5. How should our worship be different from that of creation in general? How do we know we are worshipping?
6. How does Psalm 148 shape our understanding of the church's mission?
7. How does understanding God's providence give us confidence in uncertain times?
8. How can we cultivate a heart of praise in everyday life? Think about both the ordinary and the exceptional.
