4. Why should we hold fast to our hope, according to verse 23?

5. How can believers stir up one another to love and good works? What could you do this week to encourage someone?
Read Hebrews 10:25-31. 6. What happens to those who reject Jesus' salvation?
Read Hebrews 10:32-39. 7. Describe how the original readers endured previous hardships together. What has helped you to endure hardships? Can you share a specific example?
8. According to verses 35-38, why is it important for us to endure in faith?
