

Lesson 5  
Psalm 19

Read Psalm 19:1-6 (God revealing Himself to us through Creation)

1. a. In what way do the heavens and the sky declare God's glory? What messages (speech, words, voice) are they sending out?

b. Do you know much about the stars? Do you pay attention to meteor showers? Do you prefer sunsets or sunrises? Do you enjoy clouds and storms? Think of memories when sensed God's glory through the heavens and/or sky.

2. a. What is your relationship with the sun? A sun-lover? Not so much?

b. What about the sun's heat? What does verse 6 say about it? Can you think of the time when you were the hottest because of the sun's heat? When/where were you?

Read verses 7-11 (God revealing Himself to us through Law)

3. How is the Law mentioned in the New Testament different from the Law mentioned here?

4. How do you think of the relationship between Law and Grace? Now that we have freedom and justification with God in Christ through grace, what is the purpose of the law?

5. Verses 7-9 contain 6 synonyms for the Law (ESV: law, testimony, precepts, commandment, fear, rules) and list six qualities of the Law (ESV: perfect, sure, right, pure, clean, true)  
What are the six results for us from the Law in this section?

6. a. How does the Psalmist describe the Law in verse 10?

b. How is the Law desirable or valuable? How is the law sweet?

Read verses 12-14 (Our response to God)

7. What are “hidden faults”? Hidden from whom?

8. What are “presumptuous sins”?

9. Pray verse 14.
